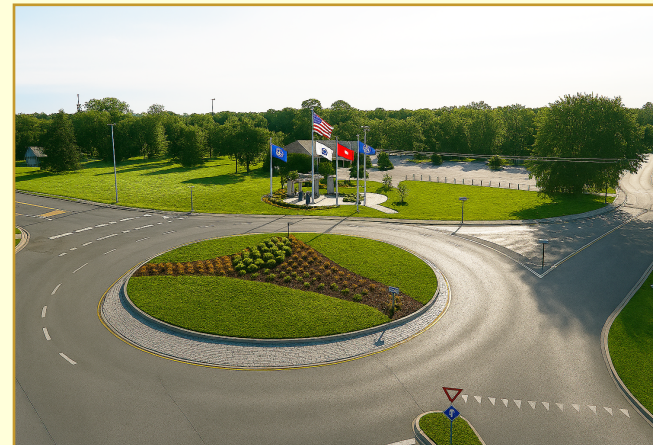


A Lasting Tribute

The Sycamore Township Veterans Memorial at Bechtold Park honors the men and women who have served our nation. Designed as a place of reflection, remembrance, and community pride, the memorial recognizes the service and sacrifice of veterans across generations.

Memorial Features

- ★ Service Monuments representing the United States Military Branches
- ★ A welcoming memorial plaza and approach walkway for reflection
- ★ Commemorative benches and recognition opportunities
- ★ Landscaped surroundings designed for ceremonies and daily visits



The Sycamore Township Veterans Memorial is located in the southwest corner of Bechtold Park at 4312 Sycamore Road, at the intersection of Plainfield and Sycamore Roads in Sycamore Township. Visitors may access the memorial from the sidewalk adjacent to the roundabout at that intersection or from a path inside the park near Bechtold Park Pavilion.
